

## MINUTES OF THE EAST END SCHOOL BOARD

A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE EAST END SCHOOL BOARD WAS HELD ON THE 20th DAY OF JUNE, 2016 IN THE BIGELOW HIGH SCHOOL FACs LAB.

PRESENT WERE SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS DENNIS BALL, KEVIN BRADKE, KENNY NAHLEN, MARGARET JOHNSON, AND WAYNE OLLES.

The meeting was called to order at 7:11 p.m.

### I. New Business

- The board discussed the CPPC/Classified Salary Schedules
  - Wayne Olles stated we are continuously adding dollar costs and once you add it, it will be very difficult to take it back. I say no at this time
  - Kenny Nahlen stated my fear is if we approve all this and then enrollment goes down we will be scrambling for money.
  - Margaret Johnson stated there hasn't been an increase to the classified employees for as long as I can remember. I think we should do something, maybe not this much but something.
  
- A motion was made by Kevin Bradke, seconded by Kenny Nahlen to approve the following changes to BHS Handbook 4.45.1:
  - Leave unchanged – “all students will enroll in one year of a foreign language”
  - Remove – “2 years of a foreign language are required to be an Honor Graduate”
  - Change – “4 semesters of Pre-AP, AP or concurrent credit to be an Honor Graduate” to “4 courses of Pre-AP, AP or concurrent credit to be an Honor Graduate”The vote was 5-0 with all being in favor. Motion carried.
  - Kevin Bradke stated between the 14-15/15-16 school year we implemented the requirements and we are going to change it now with no hard evidence if this is making an impact or not?
  - Wayne Olles stated I don't have a problem making a change just not for the kids who have already met the requirements.
  - Margaret Johnson stated I am for removing foreign language as a requirement.
  - Kenny Nahlen stated I think they need to take Spanish. If they are going into the work force vs. college, they need it more than anyone.
  - Kevin Bradke stated I say let's leave things the way they are until data can be presented.
  - Wayne Olles stated give me information with clarity or don't bring it to the board.

The board went into executive session at 8:08 p.m.

The meeting returned to an open meeting at 9:24 p.m.

- Margaret Johnson stated let's look at another revised classified salary schedule that includes the \$3000 increase to the Maintenance Director position,

increases the transportation position by \$850 instead of the proposed \$3000, cut all other increases of \$2000 and above by half and keeps all increases under \$2000 the same. We would like for Mrs. Zulpo to give us true actual figures for the 2016-2017, 2017-2018 and 2019-2020 school year.

- A motion was made by Margaret Johnson, seconded by Kevin Bradke to approve the following BHS transfers:  
Jim Brown – from Physical Education / Social Studies to Dean of Students  
Jeff Starks – from Social Studies to Physical Education  
Barry Stane – from Special Education to Social Studies  
Amy Squires – from Spanish to Special Education  
The vote was 5-0 with all being in favor. Motion carried.
- A motion was made by Margaret Johnson, seconded by Kevin Bradke to hire Chad Wilson for the senior high girls' basketball assistant. The vote was 5-0 with all being in favor. Motion carried.
- A motion was made by Kevin Bradke, seconded by Kenny Nahlen to hire Dr. Brad Gist as Federal Coordinator. The vote was 5-0 with all being in favor. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Kenny Nahlen, seconded by Wayne Olles to adjourn the meeting. The vote was 5-0 with all being in favor. Motion carried.
