- The Commissioner of Education declined the district's request to extend the Coaches Lawn Service contract so the district will bid the job out.

- A motion was made by Brandon Akridge, seconded by Margaret Johnson to accept the resignations of Shelby Horner and Courtney Mobly. The vote was 5-0 in favor. Motion carried.
- A Motion was made by Dennis Ball, no second made, to return to the lawful structure of the board as established on October 10, 2016.

- A motion was made by Margaret Johnson, seconded by Kenny Nahlen to adjourn. The vote was 5-0 with all being in favor. Motion carried.
