

MINUTES OF THE EAST END SCHOOL BOARD

A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE EAST END SCHOOL BOARD WAS HELD ON THE 15TH DAY OF MARCH, 2017. PRESENT WERE SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS DENNIS BALL, KEVIN BRADKE, MARGARET JOHNSON AND KENNY NAHLEN.

The meeting was called to order at 6:22 p.m.

I. New Business

Students A, B, and C were present along with their parents, Dr. Gist and Dr. Harris. Kevin Bradke polled the board about having individual executive sessions after each of the three hearings. The board decided to have one executive session after all hearings were over. Mr. Bradke explained the hearing process to the audience and all students requested closed hearings.

The Board retired to executive session at 7:15 p.m.

The Board returned from executive session at 8:06 p.m.

1. Student Expulsion Hearing

The closed hearing began at 6:25 p.m. The meeting returned to an open meeting at 6:33 p.m. After the executive session a motion was made by Margaret Johnson, seconded by Kenny Nahlen to expel student A for a calendar year with the provision that the expulsion was directed to be suspended and the student to be permitted to continue in school, after the expiration of the current suspension being served by the student, so long as the student and the parent agree to strict adherence to the BHS Student Handbook and to complete the following: mandatory random drug testing and other conditions including discipline and notification requirements. The vote was 4-0, with all being in favor. Motion carried.

2. Student Expulsion Hearing

The closed hearing began at 6:35 p.m. The meeting returned to an open meeting at 6:54 p.m. After the executive session a motion was made by Margaret Johnson, seconded by Kenny Nahlen to expel student B for a calendar year with the provision that the expulsion was directed to be suspended and the student to be permitted to continue in school, after the expiration of the current suspension being served by the student, so long as the student and the parent agree to strict adherence to the BHS Student Handbook and to complete the following: mandatory random drug testing and other conditions including discipline and notification requirements. The vote was 4-0, with all being in favor. Motion carried.

3. Student Expulsion Hearing

The closed hearing began at 6:55 p.m. The meeting returned to an open meeting at 7:14 p.m. After the executive session a motion was made by Kevin Bradke, seconded by Dennis Ball to expel student C for the remainder of the year with the provision that the expulsion was directed to be suspended and the student to be permitted to continue in school,

pending placement in an ALE program, after the expiration of the current suspension being served by the student, so long as the student and the parent agree to strict adherence to the BHS Student Handbook and to complete the following: mandatory random drug testing and other conditions including discipline and notification requirements. The vote was 4-0, with all being in favor. Motion carried.

A motioned was made by Kevin Bradke, seconded by Kenny Nahlen to adjourn the meeting. The vote was 4-0 with all being in favor. Motion carried.
